

- Check in with the Court Clerk's Office prior to entering the Courtroom.
- No weapons/firearms, knives, food or beverages are allowed in the Courtroom.
- All cell phones and other electronic devices are prohibited from the Courtroom. Anyone seen using a cellphone or other device will be subject to a finding of Contempt of Court, punishable by up to a \$50 fine and/or 24 hours in the Lee County Jail.
- Appropriate Attire is Required: This means:
  - NO "doo-rags," hats, or scarves;
  - NO sunglasses, backpacks or large carry bags;
  - NO white T-shirt or tank tops;
  - NO clothing showing the midriff;
  - NO spandex pants, shorts or skirts four (4) inches above the knee; and
  - NO PANTS ARE TO BE WORN BELOW THE WAISTLINE.

**IF A PERSON DOES NOT MEET THE DRESS CODE ESTABLISHED, HE/SHE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE COURTROOM.**

- No children under twelve (12) will be allowed to enter the Courtroom. If you cannot arrange for child care, you may remain in the lobby until your case is called.
- Once Court has begun, no one will be allowed to enter or leave the Courtroom until Court has concluded or a recess is taken. If you are late, report to the Magistrates' Window for instructions.
